

DARTS ATLAS SCROLLING TICKER

I just released an experimental version of a scrolling ticker feature for livestreaming integration.

As with all the other Darts Atlas livestream integrations, the ticker uses a Browser Source that loads match-contextual information.

Base Configuration

URL:

```
https://www.dartsatlas.com/matches/#####/broadcast_ticker?
resolution=RESOLUTION_OPTION
```

Resolution	Width	Height	Resolution URL Parameter
4K UHD	3840	90	4k
1080 HD	1920	45	1080
720	1280	30	720

The text size will scale with the height setting you apply. Reduce the height for a smaller size, or increase it for a larger size. You can adjust the width to whatever you want.

Branding

You can append your theme colors to the URL and they should behave as they do in your other branded widgets.

If your theme color is black (`#000000`) and your text color is white (`#FFFFFF`) then you would append the following URL parameters to your ticker:

```
?theme_color=000000&text_color=FFFFFF
```

So your full URL would become:

```
https://www.dartsatlas.com/matches/#####/broadcast_ticker?resolution=4k&theme_color=000000&text_color=FFFFFF
```

Darts Atlas OBS Script

This source will *not* be updated automatically via the Darts Atlas OBS script when you change matches. This is by design, to prevent the ticker from resetting itself while on-screen. As long as you apply a match ID of any match in your tournament or season the ticker content should remain up-to-date. The only exception would be that matches concluded *that day* would not show up among the Recently Concluded.

Content

Depending on what type of match is being streamed, the ticker may include:

- Tournament Name
- Season Name
- Host Venue Name & Address
- Season Standings
- Recent Tournament Results
- Recent Match Results
